



St. Johns Bridge Repair

About the Project:

ODOT is improving the long-term safety and lifespan of the St. Johns Bridge by repairing the concrete on the pier columns and arches under the bridge. Repairing the concrete protects the bridge's steel internal frame and reinforcements from corrosion, maintaining the service life of this beloved Portland Historic Landmark.

Pier Restoration Work Continues

Seven piers have been repaired under the St Johns Bridge. Crews restart work this December to restore this historic structure in North Portland. The project has been extended to finish work on the three remaining piers in Cathedral Park (shown below). There will be construction crews and work activities in the park near Crawford St. They will begin work by building scaffolding and wrapping around the two piers on either side of Crawford St. Thank you for your patience and support during this work.
